Actions you can take right now

Write letters to voters in Super States

Writing letters is one of the most effective ways to turn out voters—and our friends at <u>Vote Forward</u> have made it incredibly easy to do this. All you need are stamps, envelopes, a pen, a printer, and paper. If you have never written letters with Vote Forward before, <u>check out this guide</u>. You can write letters individually, or with a group, virtually.

- To write letters individually: <u>Set up an account on Vote Forward</u>. You can get started writing after you adopt and print your letters.
- To write letters with a group: We know that many groups planned on writing letters together at meetings or events this semester. Since this is no longer possible, we want to help you do so virtually, via Zoom video conference. You can create your own virtual letter writing event (see instructions below on how to use Swing Left's Pro Zoom accounts for free) or sign up for one of our weekly virtual letter writing parties.
